In an effort to support local working parents, we provide care from 6:30am to 6:30pm year-round with the exception of most federal holidays, including the week between December 25th and January 1st.

Position Overview

Bright Oak teachers will be responsible for the care of young children between the ages of 6 weeks to 5 years – teaching and guiding them through the skills needed to reach appropriate developmental and personal milestones. They are expected to create a safe and stimulating classroom environment where children are actively engaged and encouraged to succeed. In order to meet the needs of our students, teachers must be highly skilled in communicating with both children and adults alike. In addition, you must exhibit effective collaboration skills when working with other colleagues throughout the school and be comfortable to address any parental concerns in coordination with the director.

- Effectively document students' learning and growth as outlined by the Reggio Emilia Approach®.
- Daily communication with parents using the HiMama childcare management software provided by Bright Oak Preschool Academy.
- Help maintain a collaborative work environment by aiding in the training of new employees and assisting other teachers on an as-needed basis.

Additional Knowledge, Skills & Experience Required

- Two years of professional child care experience or a degree in Early Childhood Development.
- Strong oral and written communication skills + basic computer skills.
- Ability to work well with others (staff, children, and parents) and foster a team environment.
- Must clear a full background check and pass a health screening prior to start date.

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to safely lift children up to 50 pounds onto a 3ft changing table.
- Must be able to see and hear sufficiently to monitor and maintain control over classrooms of children aged 6 weeks through 5 years old.
